Registration Eligibility

1. Hockey in Wellington

There are generally about 20 or more registered schools and clubs in the primary small sticks competitions that Wellington Hockey Association administer. To ensure all clubs and schools continue to grow KJHC takes registrations for players within a designated geographic zone only.

2. Rationale for Establishing a Local Community Area

- To manage our club's growth, by registering local players only.
- To maximise our player development opportunities for children in our local community.
- To minimise administrative load and disruption that can be created through children trialling for multiple clubs or schools.
- To promote an environment where we collaboratively grow hockey across all clubs in the Wellington region.

3. Suburbs in our Local Community

The KJHC community area was developed by analysing historical suburban data that demonstrates a longstanding tradition of where our members have come from. Children living or attending school at the time of the joining the club in our local suburbs of: **Makara, Karori, Kelburn, Northland, Wilton, Thorndon, Wadestown, Kaiwharawhara, Crofton Downs, Ngaio or Khandallah** are eligible to register to play for KJHC.

The KJHC Committee can exercise its powers to approve exceptions to this policy. Where an exception is agreed to, this will be documented in the committee minutes. The Club also notes Wellington Hockey Association requires permission be sought for any U13 representative player who wishes to transfer to an alternate club.
